plus blower room.

Cost of organ and restoration (FOB Boston):  
\$256,500

Restoration includes releathering the entire mechanism, pipework cleaning and tonal finishing, console refinishing, and updating the wiring system.

Spencer Organ Company can provide restored or replicated Skinner pipework and windchests to enlarge the specification. However, we prefer not to change any existing mechanism or pipework.
