Condition of Organ:
Great and console are in good restorable condition. Swell has been somewhat water damaged. All pipework is original.

Estimated chamber size:
Two enclosed chambers
10' wide x 8' deep, plus blower room

Cost of organ and restoration
(FOB Boston) as is: \$246,500

Restoration includes releathering the entire mechanism, pipework cleaning and tonal finishing, console refinishing, and updating the wiring system.
